TENDER NO. KPA/010/2025-26/SCM - SUPPLY OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE's)

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Pursuant to clause 7.1 of the tender document, the Authority hereby issues the following clarification: -

No.	Clarification Sought	Reply
1.	Tenderers must submit audited accounts for last 3 years. We have audited accounts ready for years 2022, 2023 and 2024. Our financial year closed in December, so the accounts are still under audit process of 2025. Can you allow to submit audited accounts for 2022,2023 & 2024	Bidder must submit audited accounts for the last 3 Years. Audited Accounts for 2022,2023 & 2024 are acceptable.

Further additional information from the Procuring Entity are as follows:

- i. Bidders shall be required to view samples at the Mombasa Central Stores from **Monday 30th March 2026 to Thursday 2nd April, 2026 between 0900hours and 1500hours (Mandatory).**
- ii. Bidders shall be required to submit a written undertaking that when awarded the contract, they shall supply the uniforms as per the Authority's approved Samples and Quality Standard Specifications provided in the tender document **(Mandatory).**
- iii. Below is an additional clause to SECTION VII - SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT:

Number of GC Clause	Amendments of, and Supplements to, Clauses in the General Conditions of Contract
GCC 13.1	All deliveries shall comply with the standards of the Authority's approved sample and Quality Standard Specifications provided in the tender document. All designs work (pre-production samples) for the uniforms shall be subject to approval and signoff by the Contract Implementation Team (CIT) before final production and subsequent delivery. Supply of full order will be subject to

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
	approval of a uniform physical sample as per specifications provided in the tender document.
	Sub-standard items shall be rejected at the Supplier's cost.
	Deliveries shall be as and when required to Mombasa Central Stores, ICD Nairobi, Kisumu Port, Lamu Port or any other point of delivery as may be directed from time to time.
	Kenya Ports Authority shall reserve the right to conduct inspections at the contractors' premises during the cutting, making and trimming stage of uniform production.
	Kenya Ports Authority shall reserve the right to conduct supervision during packing and distribution of uniforms.
	Uniforms not meeting the Authority's approved samples and Quality Standard Specifications shall be rejected at the Contractor's expense.
	The Contract Performance shall be reviewed on Quarterly Basis.

Subsequently the closing date has been extended to **"BEFORE 1000HOURS ON WEDNESDAY, 15TH APRIL 2026"**.

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All other conditions of the tender remain the same.
