5. If the Tank intended to be supplied with water is full, Water will be diverted to either Pump 1,2 or 3 since they never get full (Tank capacity is 300,000 Liters each).
6. Price Schedule For Services. The Price schedule is amended to read as follows:

7. The Price for Portable Water to be quoted above must take into consideration the following parameters and any other overheads necessary to deliver water to the Port defined delivery location.
  - a) Source of water. The water source must be reliable and of the right quality.
  - b) The water must be treated and quality assurance undertaken.
  - c) Transportation and logistics costs.
  - d) Maintenance, servicing, repairs, spare parts, and depreciation of the Water Bowsers.
  - e) Water Bowser Driver wages and welfare costs.
  - f) Energy costs including pumping, treatment plants, generators, or desalination systems are involved.
  - g) Statutory charges, taxes, permits, licenses.
  - h) Operational overheads.
  - i) Suppliers profit margin.

All other conditions of the tender remain the same.
